Cumulative updates and errata to this document:

Page v, Second Edition Review Committee: the correct first name for Mr. Murphy at American PolySteel Forms is “Patrick”, not “Rich”

Page I-12, Section 2.3: The last sentence on that page is incomplete - “Flame spread rating of ICF forms that remain in place shall be less than ...“75 and smoke-development rating of such forms shall be less than 450, ASTM E-84 [10].”

Page I-18, Table 3.2: Column under 30 pcf, second line, the # sign after 32” should be deleted and included in the next column (under 45 pcf) in front of the number 4.

Page I-30, Table 4.1: The entries for the wind pressures above 80 are suppose to refer to foot note (4). Instead, the entries have the number 4 without the parenthesis resulting in three and four digit numbers for wind pressure. For example, “854” instead of “85 (4)
