Description of the State and Market Report

The Apparent Use of Portland Cement by State and Market Report summarizes estimated cement consumption in 49 different market classes for 56 state and partial-state geographic areas.

The latest edition of this report will be based on all data and revisions to construction activity for the report year through July of the following year. It will follow a format like the fictitious report presented here. This state and market information is also available for individual states.

The Apparent Use of Portland Cement by Metropolitan Area and Market Report follows a similar format for the 50 largest cement consuming metropolitan statistical areas (MSAs).
